LCA HANDBOOK HIGHLIGHTS

**Please note the following as your family is getting ready for the new school year. Make sure to read through the handbook prior to school starting. **

- PE Uniforms: Middle/High School Students LCA will be transitioning to a new PE uniform over the next year. It will still be ordered through Pataskala Customs. Your student may wear the maroon shorts and spirit wear top for this year, or you can purchase the new one. <u>Click here to order</u>
- Backpack option: Middle/High School students may choose to use a backpack to carry their books and supplies during the day. Please note that this would NOT include backpacks on rollers as that is a tripping hazard. Cell phones should remain in the off position in your locker.
- Tardy Fee: Students will receive an unexcused absence for every four unexcused tardies in a nine week period. In addition, a \$50 fee will be charged per child to the family account. All private transportation, alarm failure, oversleeping, traffic conditions, etc. are considered unexcused tardiness. If a student is late to school because of bus service, a tardy is not counted against them.
- Shoes: All dress/athletic shoe colors are within dress code. Shoes must be laced and tied. Heels/soles should not exceed 2" in height. Shoes must be fully enclosed. Boots, Crocs, slippers and Croc-like shoes are not to be worn in the classroom. This includes Ugg slippers and Birkenstocks.
- **Tights/Leggings:** All girls (1st-12th grade) Tights and ankle-length form fitting leggings (no flares or sweatpants) are permitted in a solid color, with no patterns, words or designs.

School Dismissal Manager

We utilize an on-line dismissal management system called <u>School Dismissal Manager</u> (SDM). It is dependable, easy-to-use, and can be updated by parents and guardians from the convenience of their smart phones, tablets, and PCs.

Through the on-line dismissal management system, you can:

- · Report student absences and late arrivals
- · Schedule early departures from school
- Schedule after-school activities such as scouting, clubs or sports, enrichment classes, etc.
- · Make transportation changes as late as 2:15 PM on the current day

Extended Care

- Enrollment in our extended care program is by pre-registration only for grades Pk-5. Registration information will be emailed prior to orientation.
- Before and after school Extended care fees are \$10 per student per session. These fees are due upon receipt of a monthly invoice.
- The privilege of Extended care may be revoked if the account is not kept current.
- A \$50 fee will be assessed for any late pick-up after 6:00 PM
- A non-registered student not picked up by 3:45 PM will be charge at a "drop-in" rate of \$20 per student.
